# IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: NEW MOBILE PHONE POLICY AT THE BRITISH SCHOOL OF LOME

As part of our ongoing commitment to creating a conducive learning environment at The British School of Lome, we have made an important decision regarding the use of mobile phones within the school premises. This decision also aligns with the recent guidance from the UK government to "minimise disruption and improve behaviour in classrooms".

After extensive discussions with both parents and staff, we have decided to implement a complete ban on mobile phones during school hours. Recognizing the importance of communication, especially in emergencies, we have established the following guidelines:

- **1. Emergency Calls**: If a student needs to make an emergency call, they may do so using the reception phone after seeking permission from their teacher.
- **2. Educational Purposes:** Occasionally, teachers may request students to bring their phones for educational purposes, with clear instructions provided in advance.
- **3. Morning Submission:** Students wishing to bring their phones for emergencies must submit them at the reception desk at the start of the day. They will receive a token to collect their phone after school.
- **4. Responsibility and Safety:** While we will keep phones in a secure location, please note that the school will not be held responsible for any loss or damage. We strongly advise keeping phones at home to avoid inconvenience.
- **5. Strict Enforcement:** Any student found with a phone during school hours will have it confiscated and securely stored until the end of the term.
