Message from The Head of Primary

Dear Parents and guardians,

I hope this message finds you well. I was reminded this week as I circulated around our school at lunchtime about the importance of safe ways to play.

At BSL, the safety and happiness of your children are our top priorities. To that end, we continuously strive to maintain a secure and enjoyable environment for them to play and learn. However, we need your help in reminding your children about the importance of safe play, particularly when using the climbing structure and other playground equipment.

Here are some key points to discuss with your children:

- **Play Gently**: Encourage them to play gently with their friends and avoid pushing or shoving which can lead to other things.
- **Use Both Hands**: Remind them to use both hands while climbing and always face the climbing structure rather than climbing down backwards.
- One at a Time: Teach them to wait their turn and avoid overcrowding on the equipment.
- **Appropriate Footwear**: Ensure they wear proper footwear— no slippery shoes or studded football boots— to help prevent slips and falls.
- Respect for Rules: Emphasize the importance of following the playground rules and listening to the supervising staff.
- Awareness of Surroundings: Help them understand the importance of being aware of their surroundings and the other children playing nearby.

In the Event of an Incident or Accident:

We have established protocols to handle any incidents swiftly and effectively. Our staff are trained in first aid and is committed to providing immediate care if a child is injured, we also have nurses on site and available at the infirmary at all times. Should a significant injury occur, we will contact you immediately and take the necessary steps to ensure your child's safety and wellbeing.



The Importance of Good Handwriting


Commendation for Year 2 student Viyan for Exceptional Cursive Handwriting

A croque monsieur is a simple hot, French sandwich that you can make quickly – in less than 20 minutes – with ham and cheese.

The Year 12 CAS service group decided to teach the pupils from the Vivenda School for the hearing impaired how to make this sandwich that can be eaten as a snack or a light meal during lunchtime.


The ingredients used for the sandwich were; butter, sliced mozzarella cheese, grated cheese, sliced turkey ham and sliced bread.

Take two slices of bread, butter the surfaces lightly and one surface put a slice of turkey ham and then a slice of cheese on top of the ham. Put the other slice of bread on top of the one with the ham and cheese. You may want to add some grated cheese on top of the closed sandwich. Cook both sides of the sandwich on a griddle (or a sandwich maker) for about 3 minutes on each side. Try it at home and you would love it!
