




Cricket in Full swing at BSL


NEWS FROM THE BSL LANGUAGE INSTITUTE

2063 Gender Goals: ImpactHER, African Union sign MoU on African women empowerment



ImpactHER, Africa's foremost not-for-profit organization with a mandate for empowering African female entrepreneurs by bridging the gender business financing gap so as to help them realise their full economic potential has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the African Union for gender equality and women's economic empowerment in realization of the Union's 2063 Gender Goals.

The MoU outlines a collaborative framework between ImpactHER and the African Union, focusing on strategic initiatives to empower women entrepreneurs across the continent. This partnership aims to address key challenges faced by African women in business, including access to finance, market linkages and skill development, aligning with the aspirations of Agenda 2063 for a prosperous and gender-equal Africa.

Next week they will be trying their hands at how to make a sandwich.


